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Program Overview

Our OSHC Program starts at 11:00AM and concludes at 1:00PM with lunch from 1:00PM to 1:30PM. Please arrive at 10:30AM. This allows time for the children to have recess and for our Site Interpreters to provide your Team Leaders with information about the day.

Number of students

Our group program can accommodate a maximum of 120 children. This means that other OSHC groups may be booked alongside you on any day.

Please note that this area will be available for public access during the day. It will be the OSHC staff's responsibility to watch the children in their care.

What to bring

Our program operates rain, hail or shine and we conduct the program in correspondence to the weather. However, some areas of the Gaol are not undercover. Please advise your students to bring warm clothing, raincoats, umbrellas or sun protection according to the forecast.

Activities Overview

Gaol Tales - Site Interpreter

Children are able to see and hold real artefacts from the Gaol's past, listen to true stories and ask questions with our Site Interpreter.

Gaol Break Game - OSHC Team Leader

Children have to crack a secret code to uncover a true story about Adelaide Gaol. Called "Which cell am I in", they will have to find pictures that will help crack the code.

Prisoner Recreation - OSHC Team Leader

Children can play handball and hopscotch in the prisoner's recreation area. Here they can complete their activity booklets with plenty of old school games that were played before modern technology.


Short Stay in Gaol - OSHC Team Leader

Children will be able to explore a section of the Gaol and see what Gaol life was really like!


Lunch - OSHC Group
