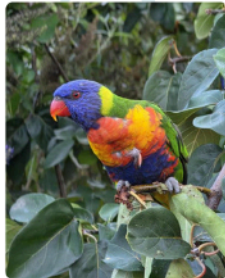

Can you spot all of these birds?

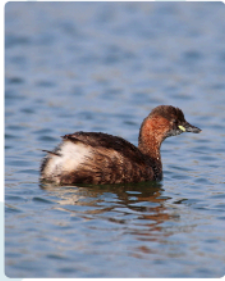


MY NAME IS:

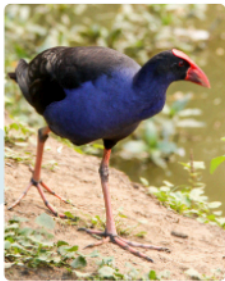

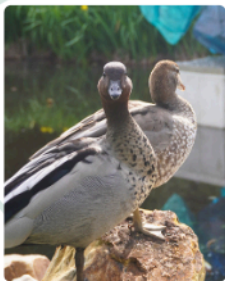
