Any photographs submitted <u>must have been taken at either Adelaide, Mount Lofty or Wittunga Botanic Gardens between September 2025 and January 2026</u>. Please limit entries to one image per student.

## **Categories:**

#### 1. Under 12: Plants, Fungi and Animals of the Botanic Gardens

Photographs that show the wonderful diversity of all living things that call the Botanic Gardens home.

### 2. Age 13 – 18: It's all about perspective

Use your creativity to photograph a unique detail, an interesting interaction between plants and animals or something that might usually go un-noticed, that shows off the different sides of living things found at the Botanic Gardens.

### 3. Open: Nature's Gallery

Demonstrate the beauty of nature from delicate patterns or bright colours to the intricate relationships found between plant, fungi and wildlife found in the Botanic Gardens.







## Steps for submitting:

- 1. All photographs should be submitted in JPEG format
- 2. Name each file with student initials and what category they are submitting to
  - a. eg: AL\_Under 12 Category or RP\_Open Category
