
Visiting **Little Sprouts** Kitchen Garden at the **Adelaide Botanic** Garden

You can eat your food here, but please don't eat any of the plants unless your Botanical Educator says it is okay!




During your visit...

You might need to use the bathroom after a long trip


These bathrooms are next to the **Kitchen Garden**

We will be in the **Kitchen Garden** for 60 minutes (1 hour)


We will stay with our group and meet a new Botanical Educator at each station

We will look at different seeds in the food we eat

You can plant your own seed in a small container to take home

Afterwards, it is important to wash our hands with soap and water






We will walk around the garden with our Botanical Educator and smell, touch and even taste some of the plants
