# G'day! Welcome to Cleland Wildlife Park

Our wide open spaces are home to over 130 species of native Australian animals including kangaroos, koalas, wombats, dingoes, Tasmanian devils, and a variety of invertebrates, birds, and reptiles.

Spread over 35 hectares, walk amongst the kangaroos, yellow-footed rock-wallabies and majestic old gum trees and enjoy the freedom to explore at your own pace.

## Choose your own adventure at Cleland



Cleland is bigger than you may expect, which gives you the freedom to either spend the day, or just a few hours here. In fact, the park is over 35 hectares and walking the entire area of the park at a brisk pace will take approximately two hours – longer if you wish to stop and feed animals or attend a keeper presentation. Cleland offers a range of opportunities to get close to some of South Australia's most iconic wildlife and the keepers who care for them.

## Be safe around our animals



One of the unique features of our park is the freedom of open spaces. To make the most of this unique experience, move slowly and quietly through the park. Remember, when animals feel safe, they are more likely to share a special moment with you.

Please do not run in the park, and remember to respect the animals by never making them feel threatened. You may notice some animals prefer their own space, but don't worry; there's no shortage of friendly faces ready to meet you.

All wildlife have the potential to carry diseases, so wash your hands before and after you visit.
