G'day! Welcome to Cleland Wildlife Park

Our park is home to over 130 species of native Australian animals including kangaroos, koalas, wombats, dingoes, Tasmanian devils, and a variety of invertebrates, birds, and reptiles.

Spread over 35 hectares, enjoy our wide open spaces to walk amongst the kangaroos, yellow-footed rock-wallabies and majestic old gum trees.

Explore at your own pace

- Cleland offers opportunities to get close to some of South Australia's most iconic wildlife.
- Cleland is bigger than you may expect and walking the entire area of the park at a brisk pace will take approximately two hours.
- Please note that the last bus departs at 5 pm and our car park gates close at 5 pm.



Be safe around our animals

- Pick up a bag of animal food to feed kangaroos, wallabies and potoroos.
- Please move slowly and quietly through the park. Do not run. When animals feel safe, they are more likely to share a special moment with you.
- You may notice some animals prefer their own space, so please do not enter the rest areas, but don't worry; there's no shortage of friendly faces ready to meet you.
- All wildlife have the potential to carry diseases, so wash your hands before and after you visit.

To help protect the animals in our care, some aviaries, bird experiences and paths are temporarily closed.

Please:

- follow the map and onsite signs for current closures, open routes and alternatives
- do not feed wild birds or birds in our care
- use shoe-washing stations where directed.

H5 avian influenza, also known as H5 bird flu, has been detected in wild birds in South Australia. The current risk of bird flu to people in Australia is low.

If you see sick or dead birds at this park

- **AVOID** contact.
- **RECORD** what you see.
- **REPORT** it to a Cleland staff member.
