Bookings & Weather

To ensure the comfort of children and families, we have a heat policy for our Children Community Programs.

If the temperature is forecast to reach 37 degrees and above at Mt Barker, all children programs will be held indoors, in air-conditioning.

Children's programs may be cancelled if a sufficient indoor space is not available, you will be notified via email if this is to occur and will be refunded in full or rescheduled.

Cancellations made by Cleland Wildlife Park may occur due to extreme weather, or other conditions, outside of the park's control. You will be notified via email if this is to occur and will be refunded in full.
