

Visitor Engagement

Tasks may include:

- Being present at key locations around the park, assisting visitors
 with directions and answering general and animal-related questions
- Select Visitor Engagement Volunteers will also be engaged in taking visitors on short volunteer guided walks
- Using display materials to engage and educate park visitors
- Be responsible for opening and closing of volunteer information booth
- Provide up to date tourist information and answer general enquiries about the park
- Promote information about events and experiences
- · Bagging up food pellets for sale in Ticket Office
- Monitor levels of food pellets and bagging supplies
- · Keep information in visitor booth updated and current

When? Requires you to commit to at least one shift per fortnight. Day, start and finish times are flexible.





Green Team

Tasks may include:

- Assist with routine maintenance of areas identified within CWP
- Maintenance of a wide range of native plants (e.g. watering and weeding tube stock and potted plants held in the nursery)
- Removal and disposal of noxious weeds by hand-pulling, using a rake/hoe, spraying or cut & swab
- Assist with the removal and disposal of fallen limbs and other debris from designated areas, displays and enclosures
- Assist with the placement of mulch onto revegetation areas, displays and enclosures
- · Assist with minor projects and repairs
- Assist with the maintenance of koala gum plantations
- Assist with the placement of tree-guards and semi-permanent fencing around plants and planted areas
- Cleaning of interpretive signage throughout park
- Collecting seed, propagating seedlings
- Preparing animal food (pellet) bags.

When? Every Tuesday for a 9am start





General Duties

Tasks may include:

- Removal and disposal of noxious weeds by hand-pulling, using a rake/hoe, spraying or cut & swab
- Assist with the removal and disposal of fallen limbs and other debris from designated areas, displays and enclosures
- Pruning overgrown / overhanging vegetation
- Assist with the placement of mulch onto revegetation areas,
 displays and enclosures as required
- Assist with routine maintenance of areas identified within the park

When? Times and days can be flexible to suit your availability.

This program is very similar to the Green Team role but does not usually involve working as a group.





Plantation Maintenance

Tasks may include:

- Travel to Koala Gum Plantations within Adelaide Hills and Fleurieu Peninsula
- Using minimal-disturbance bush regeneration techniques to control bushland weeds in a plantations
- Plant identification
- · Pruning of overhanging branches and clearing debris

When? Events will be advertised via Rosterfy.





Bush Care

Tasks may include:

- Using minimal-disturbance bush regeneration techniques to control bushland weeds in a patch of remnant vegetation within Cleland Wildlife Park
- Plant identification
- · Pruning of overhanging branches and clearing debris

When? Events will be advertised via Rosterfy.





Food Bagging

Tasks may include:

- · Bagging up food pellets for sale in Ticket Office
- Restocking display case in Ticket Office
- Monitor levels of food pellets and bagging supplies
- It is important to note that all volunteers are expected to assist with food bagging during busy periods. Many hands make light work.

When? Times and days can be flexible to suit your availability.





Animal Management

Tasks may include:

- · Assist with the cleaning of animal enclosures and display areas
- Assist with the preparation of food for captive animals and keeping food preparation area clean. This includes dishes!
- Tend to rats and mice clean cages, replenish food and water
- · Cleaning interpretive signage and enclosure glass windows
- · Wash and dry linen
- · Assist with weeding in bird aviaries
- Clean water troughs and bowls
- Assist with gathering and placement of materials to renovate exhibits
- · Assist with making animal enrichment items
- · Assist with minor projects as directed
- Assist with animal watch when required (monitor and record animal behaviour)

Requires you to commit to at least 1 shift per fortnight on a regular day (8.30am start). Vacancies in the program are limited.

It is important to note there is NO handling of animals in our volunteer program.





Koala Management

- Assist with the cleaning of animal enclosures (hosing, raking etc.)
- Assist with the cleaning/sterilisation of bottles and syringes
- Assist with the preparation and administration of food supplements
- Removes old browse and replace with fresh browse
- Cleaning interpretive signage
- Wash and dry linen
- · Clean/tidy indoor display
- · Assist in scrubbing animal perches and gum bins
- Cleaning of koala hospital room

Requires you to commit to at least 1 shift per fortnight on a regular day (8.30am start). Vacancies in the program are limited.
