	6.1	Heritage Farm (Nitschke Farm), Cudlee Creek-Lobethal Road, Lobethal (SHP 18495)	
		The Cudlee Creek bushfire that began on 20 December 2019, substantially damaged or destroyed the heritage related structures of Heritage Farm. The Council will consider whether there is no longer any justification for this place to remain a State Heritage Place. If they agree, the Council must then give notice of its intention and provide three months for feedback before it can confirm this places removal from the SA Heritage Register.	

	6.2	Klopsch Farm Complex, Neudorf Road, Lobethal (SHP 14735)	
		Klopsch Farm Complex was also severely damaged by the Cudlee Creek bushfire. Council will consider this place along the same lines as described above.
