

# Coast Protection Board Meeting

October 2022

## Key outcomes

The Coast Protection Board recently met at Port Adelaide Town Hall for Meeting 495. The formal minutes will be released onto the Board website following the next meeting 9 December 2022.

Key outcomes from the meeting included:

- **Potential reform of governance arrangements:** The Presiding Member has undertaken a review of the governance arrangements with the Board positioning itself for change while maintaining good relationships between the Board and local government.
- **Breakout Creek on the River Torrens:** The Board received a presentation from Dr Nadine Kelly, Team Leader, Urban Water with Green Adelaide on work underway at Breakout Creek on the River Torrens. Stage 3 of rehabilitation is underway with stormwater improvement wetlands being constructed to create habitat and improve water quality runoff into the Gulf St Vincent, as well as developing a shared vision to meet the community's needs.
- **Retiring members of Local Government Advisory Committee:** The contributions of Cr Bill Jamieson and Mr Peter Halton was recognised by the Board as retiring members of the Board's Local Government Advisory Committee (LGAC).
- **Board policy document update:** the updated Board Policy document which includes previously agreed appendices on boat ramps and coastal raptors, includes updated references to IPCC, relevant legislation updates including *Crown Land Management Act 2009* and the *Harbours and Navigation Act 1993*. - **Spring eNewsletter:** the Board is preparing a seasonal newsletter to improve communications about the Board and its business. The newsletter was released in November 2022.
- **Inspection of Port Adelaide:** The Board received presentations on sea level rise and sea flooding in Port Adelaide followed by a walking tour of the waterfront, including Dock One, to view the challenges and adaptation
