

Coast Protection Board Meeting

December 2025

Key outcomes

The Coast Protection Board (the Board) held Meeting 520 on 5 December 2025 at the offices of the Department for Environment and Water (DEW), 81-95 Waymouth Street, Adelaide. The meeting minutes will be released on the Board's [webpage](#) following their confirmation at the next meeting.

Key outcomes from the Meeting 520 included:

- **Submission on the Green Adelaide Draft Regional Landscape Plan 2026–2031**

The Board resolved to provide a formal submission on the Green Adelaide Draft Regional Landscape Plan 2026–2031, which was open for consultation until 19 December 2025.

- **Port Stanvac Code Amendment**

The Board considered the proposed Port Stanvac Code Amendment.

The Board noted the importance of the area's unique coastal habitat and discussed their concern regarding the exclusion of the foreshore in the Amendment area resulting in it remaining zoned 'Industrial/Strategic Employment'.

As this area falls outside the Code Amendment boundary, the Board wrote to the Department for Housing and Urban Development to formally convey its position, recommending inclusion of the foreshore in the Code Amendment and rezoning of the foreshore to 'Conservation' to ensure appropriate environmental protection of the unique coastal habitat.

- **Collaboration with other Boards**

The Board discussed opportunities to enhance collaboration with other authorities with responsibilities impacting the coast and marine environment. As part of this proactive approach, the Board intends to engage with the Stormwater Management Authority and with Green Adelaide in 2026 to support alignment of priorities and identify opportunities for coordinated action.
