7.2	<p>Former A. A. Stenross & Company Boatyard, 24 Lincoln Highway, Port Lincoln. On Barngala Country.</p> <p><i>On 10 April 2025, the Council provisionally entered the Former A. A. Stenross & Company Boatyard, in the South Australian Heritage Register as a State Heritage Place as it meets criteria (b) and (d) under s16 of the Heritage Places Act 1993.</i></p> <p><i>The period for making a public submission closed on 11 July 2025. One submission was received in favour of State Heritage listing.</i></p> <p><i>At this meeting the Council will consider whether or not to confirm the place in the South Australian Heritage Register.</i></p>	
7.3	<p>Former Malcolm Reid's Emporium, 187-195 Rundle Street, Adelaide SA 5000. On Kurna Country.</p> <p><i>On 15 January 2025, the Chair of the Council provisionally entered this place in the South Australian Heritage Register under section 17 (2) (b) of the Heritage Places Act 1993 to protect the place while it is assessed.</i></p>

		<p><i>At this meeting the Council will consider the Assessment Report and determine if the place meets any of the s16 criteria. If it does decide it meets one or more s16 criteria then, as agreed through the Supreme Court proceedings, the Council will adjourn discussion to give the owner time to make further submissions to the Council at a later meeting.</i></p> <p><i>If the Council forms the opinion that the place does not meet s16 criteria, it will remove it from the SA Heritage Register.</i></p>
