MINUTES

The 134th Meeting of the South Australian Heritage Council (the Council) was held via electronic means (Microsoft Teams) on 14 March 2023.

Statement of Acknowledgement

The Chairperson acknowledged that the land that the Council members meet on today is the traditional lands for Kurna people and that the Council respect their spiritual relationship with their country. The Chairperson also acknowledged the Kurna people as the custodians of the Adelaide region and that their cultural and heritage beliefs are still as important to the living Kurna people today.

1. WELCOME AND APOLOGIES

Mr Conlon welcomed all to the 134th meeting of the South Australian Heritage Council (the Council). The meeting was opened at 11am.

Apologies were received from Ms Jan Ferguson, Mrs Deborah Lindsay and Mr Marcus Rolfe.

2. ADOPTION OF AGENDA AND DECLARATION OF CONFLICTS OF INTEREST

Agenda

The agenda was adopted without any additions.

Declarations of conflict of interest

There were no declarations of conflict of interest. It was noted that Mrs Deborah Lindsay had declared a conflict of interest in relation to the matter to be discussed prior to the meeting. Given the whole meeting was dedicated to this matter, Mrs Lindsay registered her apologies.

3. IN CAMERA DISCUSSION

The Council had an in-camera discussion pursuant to section 7 (6) of the *Heritage Places Act 1993*.

This text was approved for release at Council's 14 August 2025 meeting.

Secretary's Office, Adelaide Showground – Amendment to Register Entry, Summary of State Heritage Place.

Mr Keith Conlon welcomed Dr Louise Bird, Heritage South Australia to the meeting. Dr Bird noted that the Royal Agricultural and Horticultural Society of South Australian (RAHSSA) has appealed two heritage listings including the Secretary's Office. These matters are currently before the Environment Resources and Development Court (ERD Court).

It was noted that on 8 December 2022, the Council amended the Register Entry for the Secretary's Office at the request of the owner's legal representative to include plans from the Heritage Agreement.

On 8 March 2023, the owner's legal counsel advised that they did not want the curtilage plan included in the Summary of State Heritage Place. If this can be resolved, it is anticipated that the applicant will discontinue the appeals. The Council are therefore asked to consider the applicant's request to remove the curtilage plan.

Council discussed possible implications of the removal. Council agreed with the recommendation to remove the curtilage plan from the Register Entry.

The South Australian Heritage Council:


