| Regions and funding available | <p>The amount of funding for each round and in each Landscapes SA region will vary depending on the number and value of SEB payments in recent years.</p> <p>Round 3 is open to landholders in the following Landscapes SA regions, with the following funding available:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Northern and Yorke: \$3.7 million Hills and Fleurieu: \$2.8 million Eyre Peninsula: \$1.5 million SA Arid Lands: \$1.1 million <p>The funding in each region may be awarded to one or more applicants, and not all funding may be allocated if suitable projects are not available.</p> |
| Conservation priorities | <p>Applications that improve habitat for threatened species or vegetation communities are preferred and will be weighted higher. Threatened species or communities are listed within the:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> National Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act 1999, State National Parks and Wildlife Act 1972, (refer schedule 7, 8 and 9), Provisional List of Threatened Ecosystems of South Australia [DEH in progress] (contained within the Grant Guideline) Regional conservation plans e.g. Landscapes SA plans |
