Application to Register a Potential SEB Credit Area

About this form

Landowners or Accredited Third Party Providers may use this form to apply to have an area of land registered as a **potential** Significant Environmental Benefit (SEB) Credit Area. Before you complete this template, please make sure you are aware of the long-term responsibilities of becoming a Credit Holder, and the duties involved in establishing SEB Credit Areas. For further information, refer to the <u>'Landholders Guide to SEB Credit'</u> or the <u>'Accredited Third Party Provider and SEB Credit Guide'</u>.

For this application, it is not necessary to have a full assessment of the vegetation or a site Management Plan. You will need to describe the vegetation types present and indicate how the site will be managed to improve the condition and/or extent of the vegetation. The vegetation can be of any type. The most valuable SEB Credit Areas, however, contain remnant vegetation that can be improved significantly in condition and/or extent.

Owners of potential credit sites are under no obligation to manage the site beyond what is required by relevant laws until credit is established. When credit is to be established, you must submit an <u>Application to Establish and Assign SEB Credit</u> form. This will require engaging an <u>NVC Accredited Consultant</u>. The Consultant will then undertake a <u>Bushland or Rangeland Assessment</u> of the site to determine the credit value and to develop an agreed Management Plan. Note: if you are certain you wish to proceed with the full process, you may apply to establish credit without listing the site as a potential site first.

Assessment

The application will be assessed by the Native Vegetation Council (NVC) against the Significant Environmental Benefit Policy (Requirements 4 to 7). If the area is deemed eligible, relevant details will be added to the Native Vegetation Credit Register.

If you are not the landowner, the landowner must co-sign this form to show their approval.

Custodians with care and control of dedicated Crown land (e.g. District Councils) should seek advice from the <u>Crown Lands Program Team</u> about the suitability of noting a SEB credit area on the title (this may require a change to the current dedication).

Pastoral lessees should consult with the <u>Pastoral Unit</u> about the possibility of a change of land use (Pastoral Board approval is required).
