

Protecting your assets and native vegetation

Approvals guide - *Kangaroo Island*

Start here



No approvals needed

- 1 **Clearance around existing dwellings**
(max. 20m but excluding large trees - see CFS)
- 2 **Clearance 10m around existing buildings**
- 3 **Fenceline fire breaks** (max. 5m)

Note: Roadside fences - can only clear 1m into roadside and 4m into own property.



Local Council approvals

- 1 **For new access points and driveways**



Native vegetation approvals

- 1 **New dwellings** *Link in QR code*
- 2 **Atypical access points**
(e.g. wider)
- 3 **Ecological burning**

CFS approvals

- 1 **Large trees around existing dwellings**
($<20\text{m}$ from dwelling)
- 2 **Reducing fuel loads in the landscape** ($>20\text{m}$ from dwelling)
- 3 **Constructing a fuel break** (max. 20m wide)
- 4 **Constructing fire access track**
- 5 **How to reduce the impact of bushfire.** *Link in QR code*
