

Quail Hunting Survey

Regulation 9 of the National Parks and Wildlife (Hunting) Regulations 2011, holders of a quail hunting permit are required to complete and lodge this Hunting Survey form within 30 days of permit expiry or revocation. If you held both a duck and a quail open season hunting permit, you must submit separate Hunting Surveys for each permit. Penalties may apply for non-lodgement of a Hunting Survey, or for making a false or misleading statement.

To complete the Hunting Survey:

- 1. Fill your personal details at the top of the survey, ensuring your permit number is correct.
- 2. Complete one row for each day spent hunting. If you hunted in multiple locations on one day, complete a separate row for each location.
- 3. For each row completed, all fields must be completed. If no quail were taken on a day of hunting, include that on the survey by recording the date and hunting location and writing zero in the number of quail taken field.
- 4. If you did not hunt in 2025, indicate that by ticking the appropriate box below.
- 5. Sign and date survey, then return via post or email to the National Parks and Wildlife Service office at the above addresses.
