## **Coast Protection Grants**

The Coast Protection Board, with the support of the Department for Environment and Water, administers grants to assist coastal councils to repair, restore and sustain South Australia's valuable coast and marine assets. Proposals should be commensurate with Coast Protection Board policy.

The South Australian Government's Securing the future of our regional coastline initiative provides an additional \$1 million in grant funding annually for regional areas.

Grant funding is available to undertake a range of projects, for example:

- Coast protection works, including seawalls, levees, beach nourishment
- Repair of storm-damaged structures
- Conservation projects, including dune rehabilitation and revegetation
- Projects that increase coastal amenity and public use of the South Australian coast
- Coastal risk management and adaptation strategies

Projects are assessed against risk-benefit criteria and funded according to priority.
