## SOUTH AUSTRALIAN HERITAGE ACT, 1978-1980 DESIGNATION OF STATE HERITAGE AREA

Where the Minister considers that an area of land is part of the physical, social or cultural heritage of the State and that it has significant aesthetic, historical or cultural interest, then the Minister may designate that area of land as a State Heritage Area.


Pursuant to the provisions of Section 13 of the South Australian Hentage Act, 1978-1980, I, Don Hopgood, Minister for Environment and Planning and Minister for the time being administering the said Act hereby designate the area defined and shown in The Schedule as a State Heritage Area.

## **DESCRIPTION OF LAND**

## THE SCHEDULE

All that land being Sections 178, 179, 187, 316, 307, 317, 318 and 344, Hundred of Clare and Sections 186 and 315, Hundred of Upper Wakefield, bounded as follows:

Commencing at a point on the south-western corner of Section 178, Hundred of Clare, thence proceeding north-easterly along the southern boundary of Sections 178 and 179, Hundred of Clare, to the south-western corner of allotment 1 of E.P. 23-2; thence proceeding southerly along the western boundary of Section 186, Hundred of Upper Wakefield; thence proceeding easterly along the southern boundary of Sections 186 and 315, Hundred of Upper Wakefield, to the south-eastern corner of Section 315; thence proceeding westerly then northerly to the south-eastern corner of Section 316, Hundred of Clare; thence proceeding northerly along the eastern boundary of Sections 316 and 317 to the north-eastern corner of Section 317; thence proceeding westerly along the northern boundary of Sections 317, 318, 344 and 307, Hundred of Clare, to the north-western corner of Section 307; thence proceeding southerly along the western boundary of Sections 307 and 178, Hundred of Clare to the point of commencement.
