Work experience and apprenticeship opportunity

WHO WE ARE LOOKING FOR

HSR (Aust) Group in partnership with Renewal SA's Works Program are looking for motivated and committed people who want to start an exciting career in a heritage trade.

Participants will perform a two-week work experience placement working on the restoration of some of Adelaide's most iconic heritage buildings, with four having the opportunity to complete a Certificate III Stonemasonry (Monumental) apprenticeship (CPC32313) with HSR (Aust) Group.

Women and Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people are encouraged to apply.

Participants must attend an information and selection session, commit to a two-week work experience placement and have:

- A White Card (CPCCWHS1001)
- A reasonable level of fitness
- Sound literacy and numeracy skills
- The right to work in Australia.

Additional eligibility criteria apply.

WHAT YOU CAN ACHIEVE

Valuable experience working on the restoration of iconic heritage buildings.

Up to four successful work experience participants will complete a Certificate III Stonemasonry (Monumental) apprenticeship (CPC32313) with HSR (Aust) Group, and will continue to develop their skills across a range of traditional trades including:

- Bricklaying
- Plastering
- Painting
- Carpentry
- Roofing.
