This was to protect the place while a full assessment was conducted.</i></p> <p><i>During the three month consultation period there were two submissions were received.</i></p> <p><i>At this meeting the South Australian Heritage Council (Council) will consider an assessment report in relation to this place and consider written and oral submissions. The Council will then make a determination whether it meets any of the criteria under Section 16 of the Heritage Places Act 1993.</i></p> <p><i>If the Council determines it meets at least one criteria, the place will be Confirmed on the South Australian Heritage Register. If the Council determine it does not meet any criteria, the place will be rejected and removed from the South Australian Heritage Register.</i></p>
