	8.2	Object – Plaque, intrinsically associated with the Remains of "Theberton Hall" Colonel William Light's House (including Underground Room, Underground Tank and Well) – Kurna Country.  <i>This Object was provisionally listed on the South Australian Heritage Register on 5 August 2021. At this meeting the Council will consider confirming it as a State Heritage Object.</i>
