An assessment has now been completed and at this meeting the Council will consider whether it meets any of the criteria for provisional entry under Section 16 of the Heritage Places Act 1993. The assessment also is recommending to Council the place be			

		considered for Designation as a place of geological and speleological significance, pursuant to section 14(7)(a) of the Heritage Places Act 1993.			
	7.2	St John Vianney Catholic Church, Kaurna Country, 544 Glynburn Road, Burnside			
		This place has been prioritised for assessment through the postwar places of worship assessment list. At this meeting, the Council will consider whether it meets any of the criteria under Section 16 of the Heritage Places Act 1993 for provisional entry in the South Australian Heritage Register.

		On 8 December 2022, the Council provisionally entered the Semaphore Carousel in the South Australian Heritage Register as a State Heritage Place as it met criteria (a) and (b) under s16 of the Heritage Places Act 1993.			
		At this meeting, the Council will consider the one submission received during the public consultation period and determine whether or not to Confirm Semaphore Carousel as a State Heritage Place in the South Australian Heritage Register.
