		Vertebrate remains dating from the Early to Middle Miocene Period (approximately 15 million years ago) into the Pleistocene Period (1 million years ago) have been described from this site.			
		At this meeting, the Council will consider Designating this State Heritage Place for its palaeontological and geological significance.
