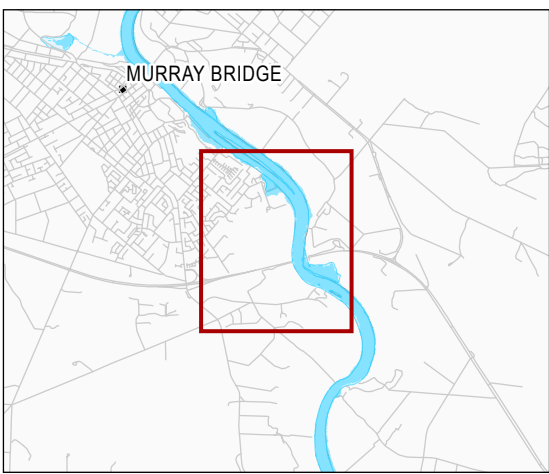
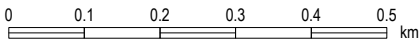




PROJECTED FLOW INUNDATION AREAS MURRAY BRIDGE, SOUTH AUSTRALIA
