Dear Mr Bowyer,

I refer to your application to the Native Vegetation Council to clear 1.7 ha of native vegetation for an industrial subdivision at Robe (Lot 2001 DP 82834 Hd Waterhouse).

The Native Vegetation Assessment Panel (NVAP) considered your clearance application at its meeting held on 19 April 2022 in conjunction with reports from the Limestone Coast Landscape Board and the Native Vegetation Branch.

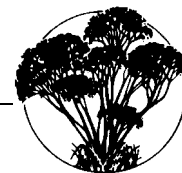

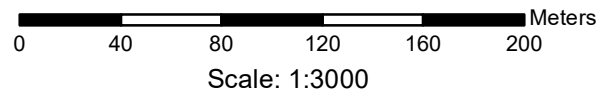
