

River Murray Business Levee Embankments Engineering Support Grant



Purpose of the Grant

In preparation for the 2022-23 River Murray flood event, it is acknowledged that some businesses are investing in the remediation of existing, or construction of new levee embankments to protect their assets. To ensure integrity of these levee embankments, specialist engineering advice is required to ensure they are remediated or constructed appropriately.

The River Murray Business Levee Embankments Engineering Support Grant will provide financial assistance up to \$1,000 to assist businesses in funding appropriately qualified Engineering Service providers to advise them in the remediation or construction of their own flood protection.

Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible for funding through the River Murray Business Levee Embankments Engineering Support Grant, businesses must:

- ☐ Hold their own ABN
- ☐ Demonstrate the assets at risk are located within the mapping zone at 200GL/day (Flow at the SA Border) flood, and the flooding risk is not otherwise mitigated through other means (eg through construction of new Council owned levee embankments). - ☐ Engage an appropriately qualified Engineer (this engineering service provider must have their own ABN) and receive advice during the period 1 October 2022 and 31 January 2023.

Process

Applications for a River Murray Business Levee Embankments Engineering Support Grant can be made once advice has been received and costs have been paid for in full.

Terms and Conditions

- ☐ Government accepts no responsibility for advice received, or for levee construction or remediation works undertaken in accordance with this advice.
- ☐ A Grant of up to \$1,000 per property applies under this program, and will be limited to one per business (unless otherwise agreed).

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- ☐ Payment will be made on a reimbursement basis (unless otherwise agreed) by providing a copy of a paid Tax Invoice (with proof of payment) for completed works from the Engineering Service Provider.
- ☐ Engineering Services received between period 1 October 2022 through to 31 January 2023 are eligible under the program. Engineering services engaged or advice received after 31 January 2023 will not qualify for a grant under this program.
- ☐ Engineering advice required for any levee embankment remediation or construction works must be claimed under this grant.
- ☐ Engineering costs cannot be claimed under the River Murray Business Levee Embankments Remediation & Construction Grant.
