	8.1	<p>No. 1 Cargo Shed, (former Fishermen's Wharf Markets) Port Adelaide</p> <p><i>The Council will consider an urgent nomination that has been received for No. 1 Cargo Shed (former Fishermen's Wharf Markets), Port Adelaide, noting there is development approval for demolition of the shed.</i></p>
	8.2	<p>Wudinna reassessment.</p> <p><i>On 11 November 1999, the Council provisionally entered and designated Mount Wudinna and Environs (Mount Wudinna, Little Wudinna, Polda Rock and Turtle Rock) as a place of geological significance. The Council confirmed the listing on 16 March 2000 as it was deemed to meet criterion (c) under s16 criteria of the Act. This place has been reassessed to deem whether more parcels of land relating to the listing are required to be listed.</i></p>
