## Permission to enter land for the purpose of taking protected animals in accordance with a Permit to Destroy Wildlife

Any person wishing to take (e.g. destroy) protected animals must apply for a Permit to Destroy Wildlife. Permit applicants can nominate other persons to destroy wildlife on the property they own or occupy if they hold a valid and current firearms license. These persons must be nominated on the permit application and listed on the Permit to Destroy Wildlife (if granted) and comply with all limitations, restrictions, and conditions of the permit.

Under Section 64 of the *National Parks and Wildlife Act 1972* (the Act), it is a criminal offence to be on any land for the purpose of taking a protected animal, or the eggs of a protected animal, unless that person has the written permission of the landowner to be on the land for that purpose. The Act specifies that the written permission must have been given not more than six months beforehand.

This form may be completed by a landowner or occupier to give written permission for a person to take protected animals on the property they own or occupy for the purpose specified below.
