Improve access for maintenance staff



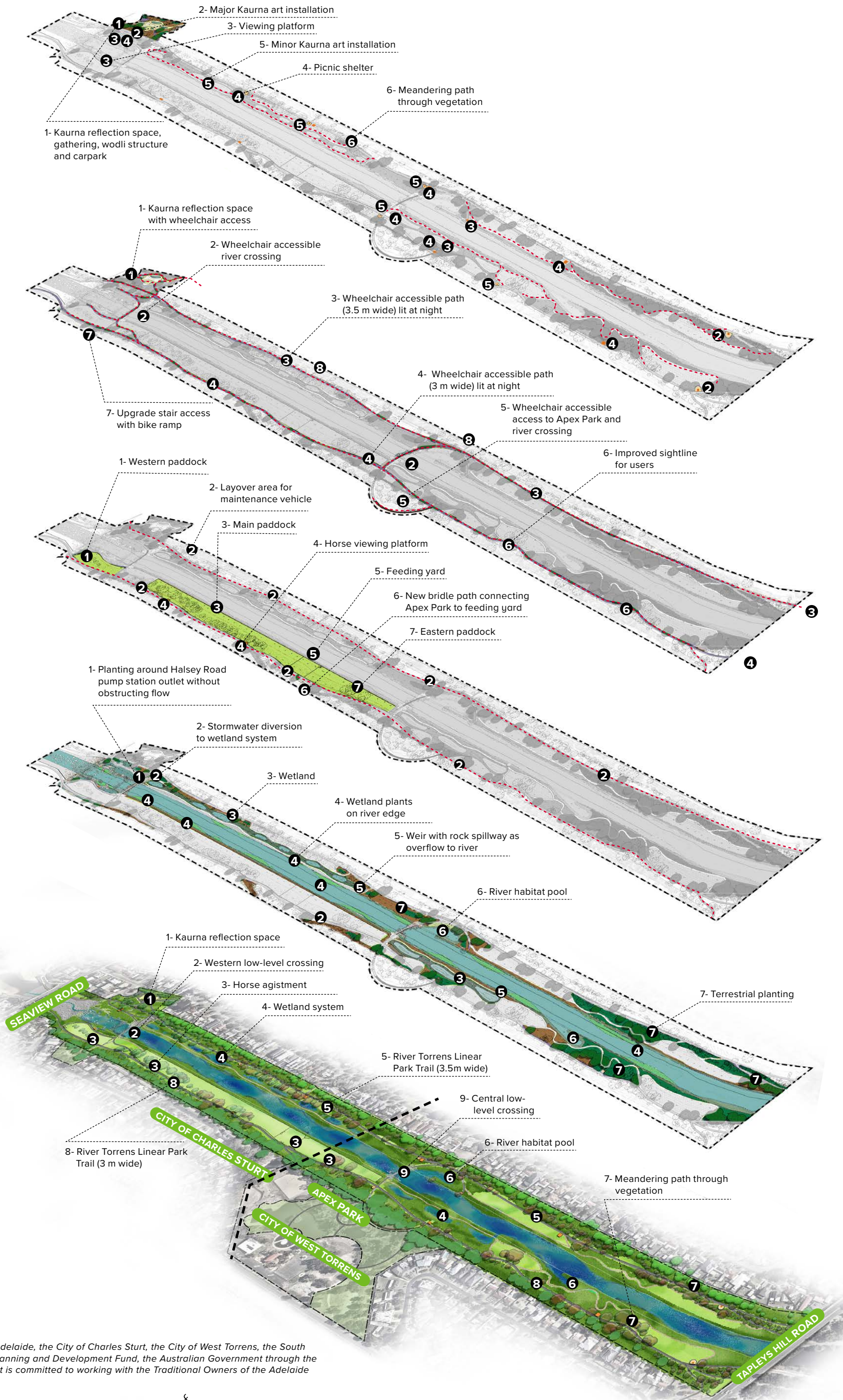
Improve water quality while maintaining flood conveyance
