

Eyre Peninsula Landscape Board temporary electric fencing (RAPPA) systems

Frequently asked questions

What is available to hire?

A temporary electric fencing system with 3 wires to run out to 800m in length. The RAPPA system fits onto an ATV. The fence system is a complete unit with an energizer, all tread-ins, wire, posts and clips available for loan in one package. A fence voltmeter is included too so you can test the conductivity of your fence.



How long can I have the fencing system for?

Up to 6 weeks, free of charge.

What purpose can the fencing be used for?

To fence stock from fragile soil areas in a paddock to increase soil cover. To manage stock into a confined area while feeding them, spelling paddocks to allow plant cover to establish or recover from grazing. Assist in grazing stubbles or pastures to reduce tracking and keep a minimum soil cover of 50% across the paddock over summer and autumn.

How will the Board decide who to loan the RAPPA fencing systems to?

The fence loan will be prioritised for land managers who are struggling to meet the requirement of the *Landscape South Australia Act* to prevent the degradation of land under their management. This includes: a change in the quality of the land, or loss of soil that has an adverse effect on the productive capacity of the land, or on water, native vegetation or other natural resources. It also includes landholders who have significant fragile soil issues on their property.
