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|           | <p>S Hearn provided an overview of the paper and the background of the proposed declaration. The Board previously approved to provide a recommendation to PIRSA to Declare <i>Pinus radiata</i> in 2022 but PIRSA's consultation raised concerns by landholders and businesses. This further consideration looks to use a different part of the Act which does not enforce a blanket ban but rather, allows the Board to provide direction to control wildlings. Clarification was sought by Board Members on responsibility for roadside wildlings with it being confirmed that the adjacent landowner holds the responsibility to control them. Concerns were raised regarding potential costs to landholders Section 192(3) of the <i>Landscape Act</i> gives Landscape Boards the right of cost recovery for control measures but, it was noted we have yet to use this for other declared weeds. J Sullivan, P Edwards and D Green are continuing to provide support to the subcommittee members outside of meetings by allowing time for them to sit down and talk through their questions and concerns. Staff have been thankful for the level of questioning and the level of detail being considered by the members and their continued examination of the science behind the recommendations. The subcommittee is keen to explore the potential to develop a policy that recognises the relationship between riparian vegetation, good watercourse management and aquatic ecosystem risk and initial discussions with DEW policy indicate it would be possible to develop a policy that allows a greater level of water take on properties that have retained and protected riparian vegetation or that undertake restoration works. More work is required to understand how such a policy would work and be assessed and what appropriate water take would be.
