### Classroom session with plants for students

A 45-minute in-class session delivered by an Education Officer on local threatened flora and fauna of the Riverland, with a focus on regent parrots. Students will take home a local native plant that provides food for regent parrots, along with a card to gift to their 'precious person.'

### Mini in-school planting session

Education Officer(s) will facilitate the planting of a small number of local native plants on the school grounds. This session is suited to one class, planting 10–30 plants in a garden bed or other suitable area. It includes an introductory talk on local threatened species. A double lesson is required.
