2 - Deputations and Presentations

2.1 **Statement of Commitment**

The Statement of Commitment is a state-wide document supporting stronger relationships with Aboriginal people and organisations in South Australia. The Presiding Members of all landscape regions have signed to commit to working in partnership to look after our country and sea.

The Northern and Yorke region supports the Statement of Commitment in numerous ways including the Aboriginal Engagement Committee, Healthy Country Planning, the Marna Banggara project and the Aboriginal Engagement Strategy.

3 - Strategic Items

3.1 **Burra Creek Water Monitoring**

The Region's Monitoring and Evaluation Officer joined the meeting to discuss two existing water monitoring sites in the Burra Creek. They were previously under the care of a neighbouring NRM board and following transition and boundary reallocation, merged to the NY region. A discussion ensued on the future responsibility of the two sites.

- there is one surface and one ground water site
- community members have been collecting the relevant data and it was advised they are keen to continue
- a contract is currently in place until end of June 2022 and may be extended.

• support the General Manager in commencing negotiations with the Department for Environment and Water (DEW) regarding the transfer of responsibility for the monitoring and maintenance of two (2) water monitoring sites along the Burra Creek to DEW
