The Northern and Yorke region spans 38,500 square kilometres of varied landscapes, from the southern Flinders Ranges to Yorke Peninsula and 1,300 kilometres of coastline. These ecosystems support a remarkable diversity of native fauna, including amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals adapted to coastal, woodland and rangeland habitats.

This inventory documents native animal species recorded in the region, providing essential baseline data for conservation planning and landscape management. Conservation status indicators identify threatened species requiring targeted protection, supporting the Northern and Yorke Landscape Board's biodiversity management priorities.

Through informed management and community engagement, the Northern and Yorke Landscape Board works to safeguard these species and the ecosystems they depend on.
