Species list: native flora

The Northern and Yorke region spans 38,500 square kilometres of varied landscapes, from the southern Flinders Ranges to Yorke Peninsula and 1,300 kilometres of coastline. This diversity of habitats supports over 1,200 species of native vascular plants across coastal, mallee, woodland and grassland vegetation communities.

This inventory documents native plant species recorded across the region, providing a comprehensive baseline for understanding and managing the area's botanical diversity. Where relevant, conservation status indicators highlight species requiring targeted protection.

Through informed management and community engagement, the Northern and Yorke Landscape Board works to safeguard these species and the ecosystems they sustain.
