Species list: non-native flora



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The Northern and Yorke region spans 38,500 square kilometres of varied landscapes, from the southern Flinders Ranges to Yorke Peninsula and 1,300 kilometres of coastline. These diverse environments are vulnerable to a range of non-native plant species that displace native vegetation, reduce agricultural productivity and degrade habitat.

This inventory documents non-native plant species recorded across the region, providing essential information for targeted weed management and control programs. Understanding the distribution and impacts of these species enables strategic intervention to protect native flora, support sustainable land use, and maintain landscape health.

Through coordinated control efforts and community participation in weed management programs, the Northern and Yorke Landscape Board works to reduce the impacts of weeds and protect the region's ecological and productive landscapes.
