


2020-21 Annual Water Use Surveys -Marne Saunders PWRA

Reporting your annual water use by each licensee is a requirement of the Water Allocation Plan for the Marne Saunders Prescribed Water Resource Area (PWRA). This survey gathers information about how people used their allocation over the water use year, and how this may change in the future. This information is important for managing water resources in the region, based on changing needs of the community and climate.



Number of responses indicating how (licensed) water was used in 2020-21



















Years with good rainfall often see less water extracted from both groundwater and watercourse.



Note: total rainfall is shown per calendar year e.g. total rainfall for 2012 at Keyneton was 294 mm showing in the 2012-13 water year
