

On-Farm Carbon Storage Grants

Northern and Yorke Landscape Board

The Northern and Yorke Landscape Board (NYLB) is offering primary producers grants to help improve carbon storage. **Applications close 30 September 2025. Applicants can apply for a revegetation pack OR improved grazing management grant – not both.**

Revegetation packs

OR

Improved grazing management grants

Packs of approx. 200 native plants, stakes and tree guards suitable to revegetate 0.5 hectares.

Valued at \$1000

Landholders must cover all other costs to establish the plants.

One pack is available per business on a first come first served basis up to a maximum of 100 packs. We anticipate this will enable all eligible primary producers to receive a pack.

Fencing and/or water infrastructure to enable stock to be rotated through an increased number of paddocks to improve pastures.

\$5 per hectare improved up to a maximum of \$5000

Grants are available on a first come first served basis.

Who is eligible?

Primary producers that own or manage a primary production enterprise that:

- Have attended a NYLB carbon farming workshop in 2024 or 2025 or the Carbon Ready Ag conference in August 2025;
- Is predominantly located within the NYLB region; and
- Receives the majority (>50%) of income from primary production under normal seasonal conditions.
- Has not received State and/or Commonwealth funding for the works previously.

What is ineligible?

- Labour (in-kind), vehicles and travel costs.
- Utilities and operating costs of the business.
- Retrospective reimbursements.
- Purchasing new or repairing machinery.
- Repairing existing infrastructure.
