Management Plan Amendments

The Neptune Islands Group (Ron and Valerie Taylor) Marine Park Management Plan was adopted in 2012. It provides the statutory basis for the management of Neptune Islands Group (Ron and Valerie Taylor) Marine Park. It is a strategic document that defines the boundaries of the various zones and sets out strategies to address management challenges.

The Minister for Environment and Water may amend a marine park management plan at any time. As required under the Marine Parks Act 2007 a draft amendment must first be prepared and released for public consultation.

The Neptune Islands Group (Ron and Valerie Taylor) Marine Park Management Plan was amended by the Neptune Islands Group (Ron and Valerie Taylor) Marine Park Management Plan Amendment 2020 (2020 amendment), adopted by the Minister for Environment and Water on 17 September 2020.

Further amendments are now proposed to the Neptune Islands Group (Ron and Valerie Taylor) Marine Park Management Plan as amended by the 2020 Amendment.

The Neptune Islands Group (Ron and Valerie Taylor) Marine Park Management Plan Draft Amendment 2021 is now released for public consultation.




