# Minister's Foreword

The Nuyts Archipelago Marine Park Management Plan was adopted in 2012. It provides the statutory basis for the management of Nuyts Archipelago Marine Park. It is a strategic document that defines the boundaries of the various zones and sets out strategies to address management challenges.

The Minister for Environment and Water may amend a marine park management plan at any time. As required under the Marine Parks Act 2007, a draft amendment must first be prepared and released for public consultation.

The Nuyts Archipelago Marine Park Draft Management Plan Amendment was released for public consultation from 27 May until 10 July 2020 and again from 19 November until

31 December 2021. All submissions received were considered during the preparation of this final management plan amendment.

I am pleased to adopt the Nuyts Archipelago Marine Park Management Plan Amendment in accordance with Section 14 of the *Marine Parks Act 2007*.

## Amendment 1 – Sanctuary Zone (SZ-8)

## Amendment 2 – Special Purpose Area (Commercial Abalone Fishing Allowed) (SPA-6)

This amendment has established a Special Purpose Area (Commercial Abalone Fishing Allowed) SPA-6. This Special Purpose Area overlays St Francis Island, Smooth Island and Dog Island located within Sanctuary Zone 8

6.2.5. Special Purpose Areas (Commercial Abalone Fishing Allowed)

The following area is identified as a Special Purpose Area (Commercial Abalone Fishing Allowed) in accordance with section 13(1)(c) of the Marine Parks Act 2007:

(a) the area defined in map 05(A) and referred to as SPA-6;

Notwithstanding the zoning of the area, the following activities will be permitted in the Special Purpose Area (SPA-6) listed above:

(a) the taking of abalone by the Commercial Abalone Fishery.

This amendment has altered the boundaries of HPZ-1.

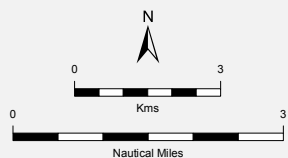
### Map 01(A) - Sanctuary Zone 1, Habitat Protection Zone 1, Special Purpose Area 4

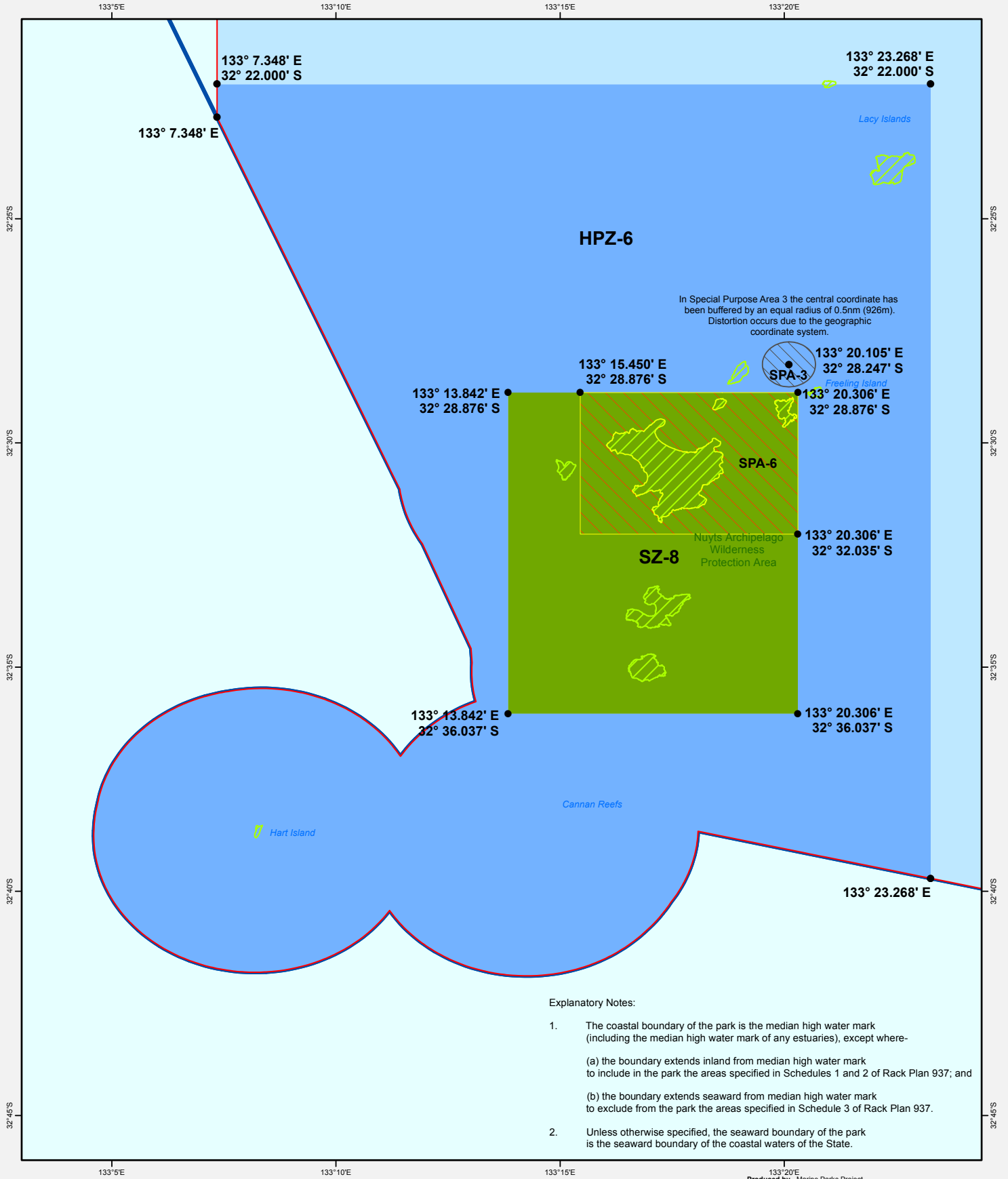

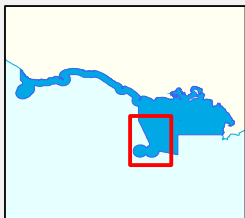

### Map 05(A) - Sanctuary Zone 8, Habitat Protection Zone 6, Special Purpose Area 3 and 6

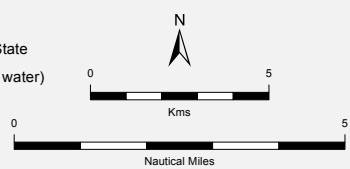
