RECORD OF MEETING

- Preliminary sanctuary zone scenarios for the Kangaroo Island Marine Parks were presented by DENR staff as a starting point for discussion.
- The 35 members of the community in the gallery were encouraged by the Chair to have input at the meeting and to attend future meetings.
- There was a consensus among the MPLAG members that zones need to be changed.
- Members felt that they had the ability and the local knowledge to advise the DENR staff of those changes.
- There was a need for more details on future maps.
- Members wanted to ensure that there wasn't a large time gap until the next meeting.
