### 4. Agenda Items

#### 4.1. Overview of the Marine Parks (Simon Clark)

### 4.2. Terms of Reference (TOR) (Simon Clark)

Discussion about *Terms of Reference* for MPLAGs (distributed). Hard copies of the TOR were also distributed to members. Key points were discussed, covering the establishment, objectives and functions of the MPLAGs.

#### 4.3. Community input - mapping (Jon Emmett)

DEH presented South Australia's Marine Parks Information Tool (SAMPIT). SAMPIT is an information gathering tool designed to capture information on the local community's use of areas. It also enables community to input local knowledge of their environment, which can complement scientific knowledge.

DEH also shared the experience of the Encounter Marine Park pilot process, in which some local success has been achieved in the Victor Harbor area in developing a zoning plan which is supported by both local fishers and DEH. The key to the success of the process was described as the willingness of all parties involved to discuss and share information openly.

Hard copies of the SAMPIT for three areas (Gambier Islands Group, Neptune Islands Group and Thorny Passage Marine Parks) were distributed. The process of filling in the hard copies was explained. The members were also shown how to put information into SAMPIT online at <a href="https://www.marineparks.sa.gov.au">www.marineparks.sa.gov.au</a>

Some members indicated a willingness to use the online version while others felt the hard copy would better suit themselves and their contacts in the community.

#### 4.4. Community input – marine parks values (Jon Emmett)

The objective of the Values Statements was discussed.

Input by MPLAG members is required to evaluate the contents and add additional information

Reply paid feedback forms were distributed to MPLAG members. Forms should be returned by March 19, 2010.

### 4.5. Communication plan (Simon Clark)

MPLAG members to collect information from the public via SAMPIT. They need to identify what information is to share, who it is distributed to, by what method and when it will be done.

  - o Use and promote the use of SAMPIT with members' local communities.
- There was recognition of the confidentiality of commercial information and that the collection and usage of data needs to be managed sensitively.
