Members advise that the following outcomes were achieved at the meeting:

- Preliminary sanctuary zone scenarios were discussed and shared with MPLAG members and members of the gallery.
- MPLAG members began the critical task of reviewing the preliminary scenarios and several alternative proposals were suggested.
- Significant changes were recommended for Zone A, B, & C and Zone D caused greatest concern to MPLAG members and gallery members.
- The members were given guidelines about how alternative zones could be designed.
- A plan on how the MPLAG members would involve local community members over the following months was devised and agreed upon.
- The MPLAG chair agreed to discuss the Marine Parks Management issues with the membership.
- Gallery members left their contact details, which the MPLAG Executive Officer, David Pearce, will ensure are followed up.
