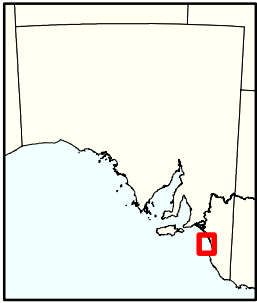

A1 orange, suggested alternative (allows beach fishing except for 3km along the northern extent)

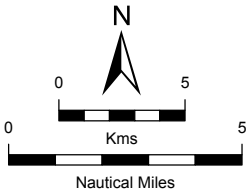
A2 purple, suggested alternative (allows beach fishing except for 3km near the middle of the zone)

B1 yellow, suggested alternative (eastern boundary 3 km from the shoreline to allow for high use of boat fishing along the coast in this zone)

Zone	Comment number (or colour)	Comment
A	A1 – orange	Similar to the preliminary sanctuary zone location and size, but reduces the beach overlay to 3km.
	A2 – purple	Alternative of similar size as the preliminary sanctuary zone but located further south, beach overlay of 3km.
	3 - comment	Used by commercial fishers to within a half of nautical mile from the shore.
B	B1 - yellow	Similar size as the preliminary proposed sanctuary zone, but moved 3 km offshore to allow for high use of boat fishing in this area.
	2 – comment	There should be some overlay of the shoreline.
	3 – comment	There should be consideration of small boat fishing accessibility and safety versus having beach overlay.
	4 – comment	This stretch of coast is very popular for fishing.
