**There were general comments regarding the issue of threats to the marine environment, displaced effort compensation for commercial fishers, the science behind sanctuary zones and the overall size of the possible sanctuary zones presented by DENR.**

**Some of the possible sanctuary zone scenarios for Marine Park 19 provided to the LSE MPLAG members in November 2010 and the alternative suggestions and comments from MPLAG members and the general public were presented and discussed.**
