Members advise that the following outcomes were achieved at the meeting:

- The MPLAG and gallery members were updated on the marine parks planning process, the role of the MPLAG members, other stakeholder involvement in the process and the focus of this meeting.
- The MPLAG and community members shared feedback and discussed zoning alternatives that they had received from their community since the previous meeting.
- The MPLAG group will not accept more than 6% of Sanctuary Zone for the park. They will not put lines on the map at this stage but will adhere to the design principles. The membership would like to see some protection for Coobowie (by adding to the existing aquatic reserve) and Pt Davenport estuaries, as well as adding to the existing aquatic reserve at Troubridge Hill.
- The membership would like to consult further with the communities of Coobowie, Edithburgh and Point Moorowie in developing the sanctuary zones.
- Gallery members were offered the opportunity to ask questions through the chair and contribute advice on preferred zoning.
