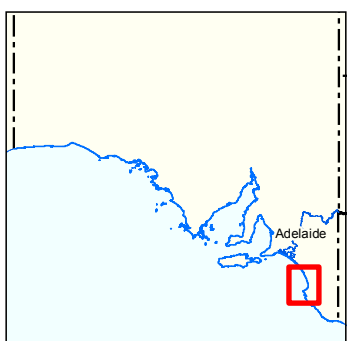
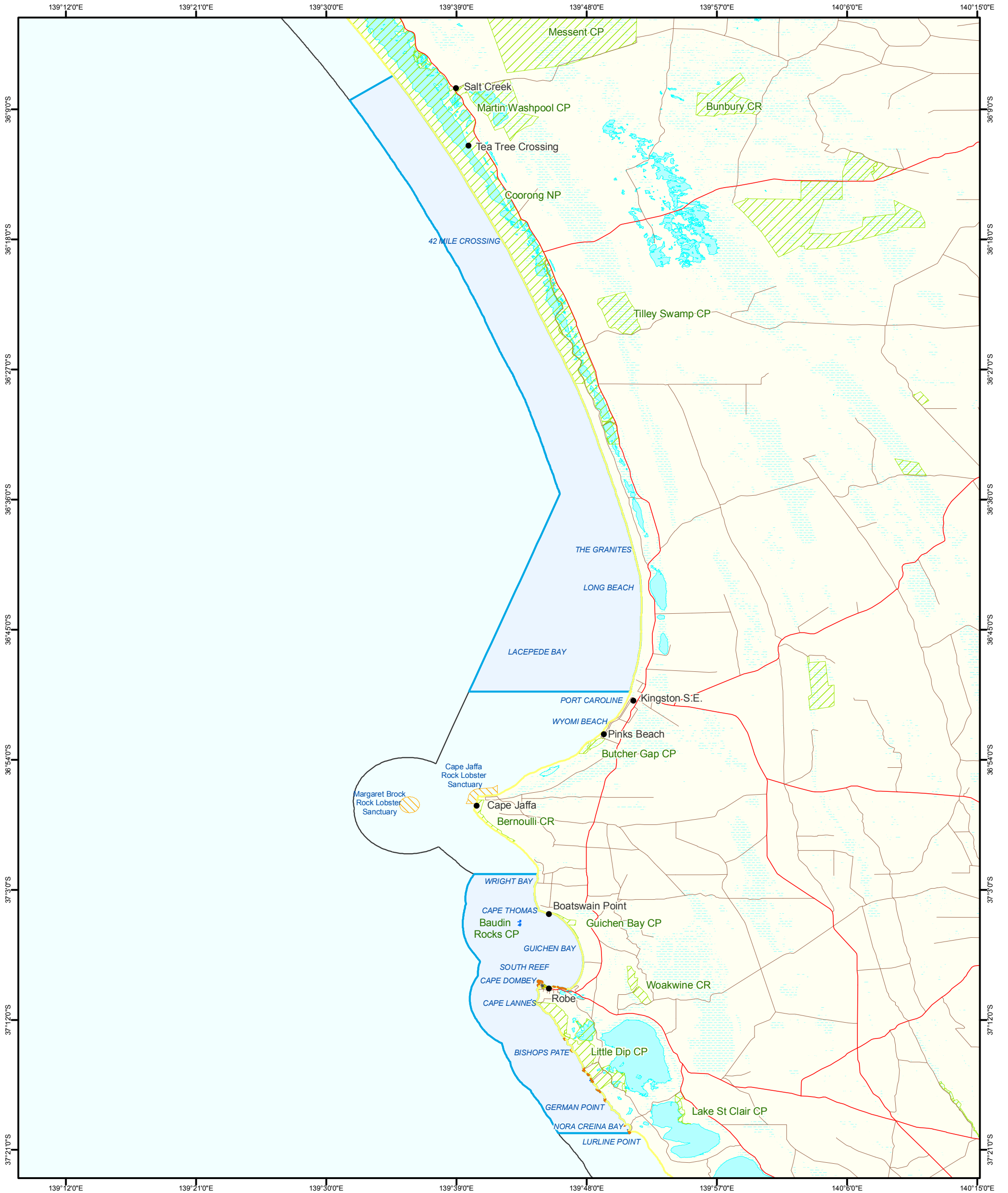
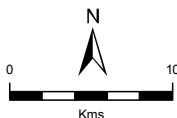


# Figure 7: Upper South East Marine Park
