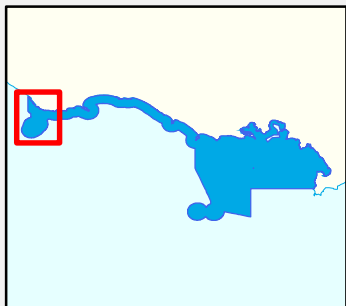

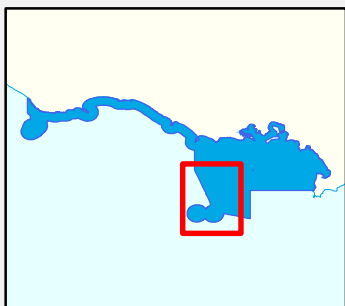

### Map 05(A) - Sanctuary Zone 8, Habitat Protection Zone 6, Special Purpose Area 3 and 6

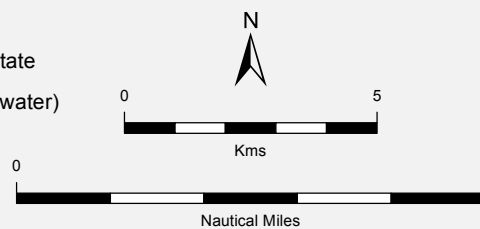
