Draft Management Plan Amendment 2020

Management Plan Amendments

The Nuyts Archipelago Marine Park Management Plan was adopted in 2012. It provides the statutory basis for the management of Nuyts Archipelago Marine Park. It is a strategic document that defines the boundaries of the various zones and sets out strategies to address management challenges.

The Minister for Environment and Water may amend a marine park management plan at any time. As required under the *Marine Parks Act 2007*, a draft amendment must first be prepared and released for public consultation.

The Nuyts Archipelago Marine Park Management Plan Draft Amendment is now released for public consultation. Members of the public are invited to make a submission.

After all submissions have been received and considered, a final marine park management plan amendment will be prepared and forwarded to the Minister for Environment and Water for consideration, together with an analysis of submissions received.

This draft amendment proposes the following alterations to the Nuyts Archipelago Marine Park Management Plan.

Amendment 1 – Habitat Protection Zone (HPZ-1)

This amendment is proposed in response to alterations proposed for SZ-1 (Amendment 3). It will alter the boundaries of HPZ-1.

Current plan content

Page 14 (6.1.2. Habitat Protection Zones)

(a) the area defined in map 01 and referred to as HPZ-1;

Replace with the following:

(a) the area defined in map 01(A) and referred to as HPZ-1 (see map 01(A) attached);

Amendment 2 – Habitat Protection Area (HPZ-6)

This amendment is proposed in response to alterations proposed for SZ-8 (Amendment 4). It will alter the boundaries of HPZ-6.

Current plan content

Page 14 (6.1.2. Habitat Protection Zones)

(f) the area defined in map 05 and referred to as HPZ-6;

Replace with the following:

(f) the area defined in map 05(A) and referred to as HPZ-6 (see map 05(A) attached);

Amendment 3 – Sanctuary Zone (SZ-1)

This amendment is proposed to expand SZ-1.

Current plan content

Page 14 (6.1.3. Sanctuary Zones)

(a) the area defined in map 01 and referred to as SZ-1;

Replace with the following:

(a) the area defined in map 01(A) and referred to as SZ-1 (see map 01(A) attached);

Amendment 4 – Sanctuary Zone (SZ-8)

This amendment is proposed to expand and alter the boundary of SZ-8.

Current plan content

Page 14 (6.1.3. Sanctuary Zones)

(h) the area defined in map 05 and referred to as SZ-8;

Replace with the following:

(h) the area defined in map 05(A) and referred to as SZ-8 (see map 05(A) attached);

Amendment 5 – Special Purpose Area (shore-based recreational line fishing) (SPA-4)

This amendment is proposed to extend SPA-4 to correlate with alterations proposed to SZ-1 (Amendment 3).

Current plan content

Page 15 (6.2.4. Special Purpose Areas (shore-based recreational line fishing))

(a) the area within 100m seaward of the line defined in map 01 and referred to as SPA-4;

Replace with the following:

(a) the area within 100m seaward of the line defined in map 01(A) and referred to as SPA-4 (see map 01(A) attached);

Amendment 6 - Boundary Definition Maps

This amendment is proposed to confirm the maps that will define the altered zone boundaries.

Current plan content

Page 15 (6.3 Boundary Definition Maps)

The zones and special purpose areas identified above are defined in Boundary Definition Nuyts Archipelago Marine Park Maps 00-08 (refer Appendix 1).

Replace with the following:

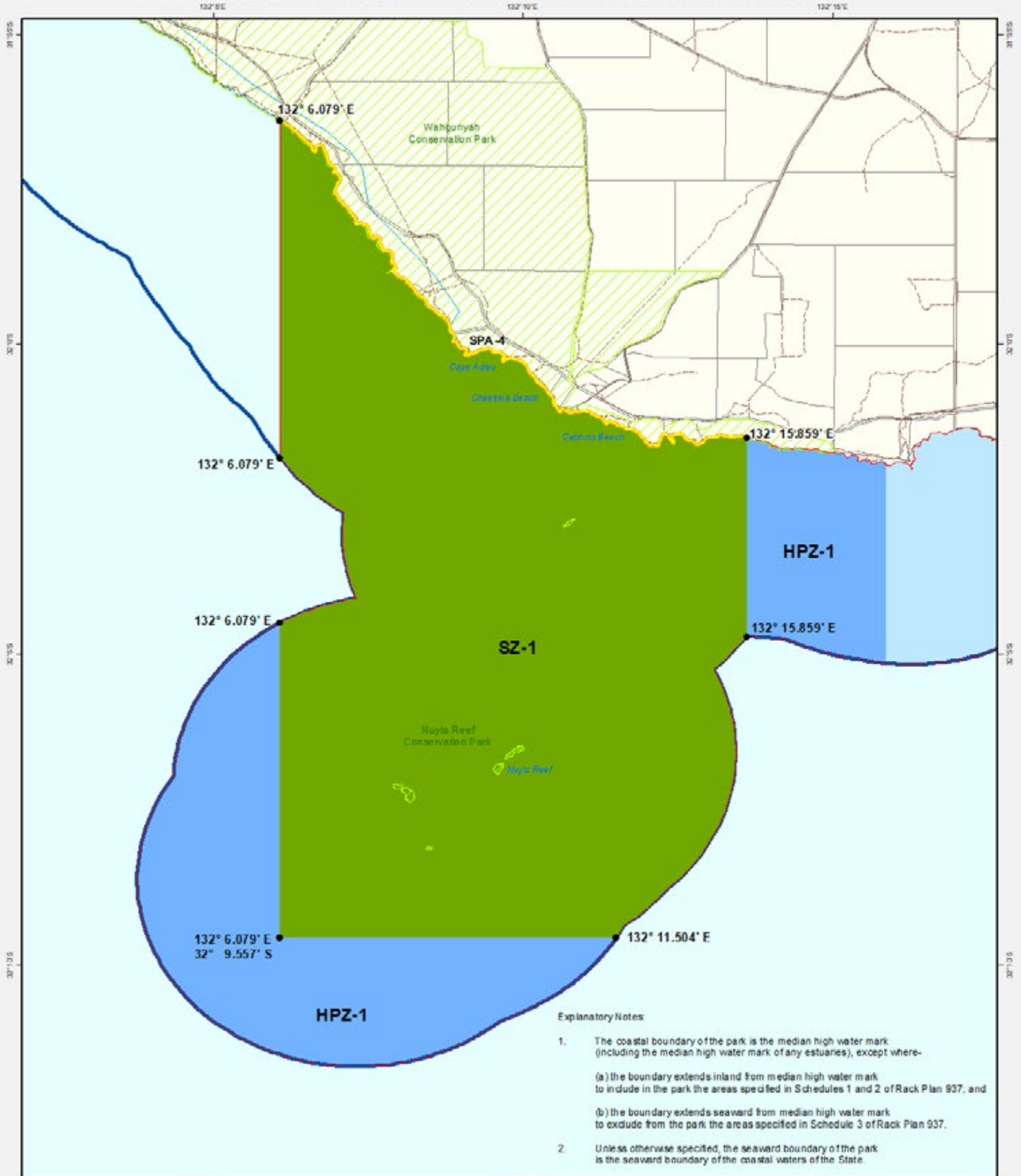
Map 01 and map 05 are deleted.

Map 01(A) - Sanctuary Zone 1, Habitat Protection Zone 1, Special Purpose Area 4



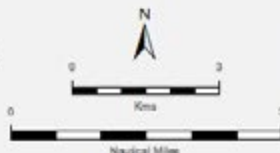

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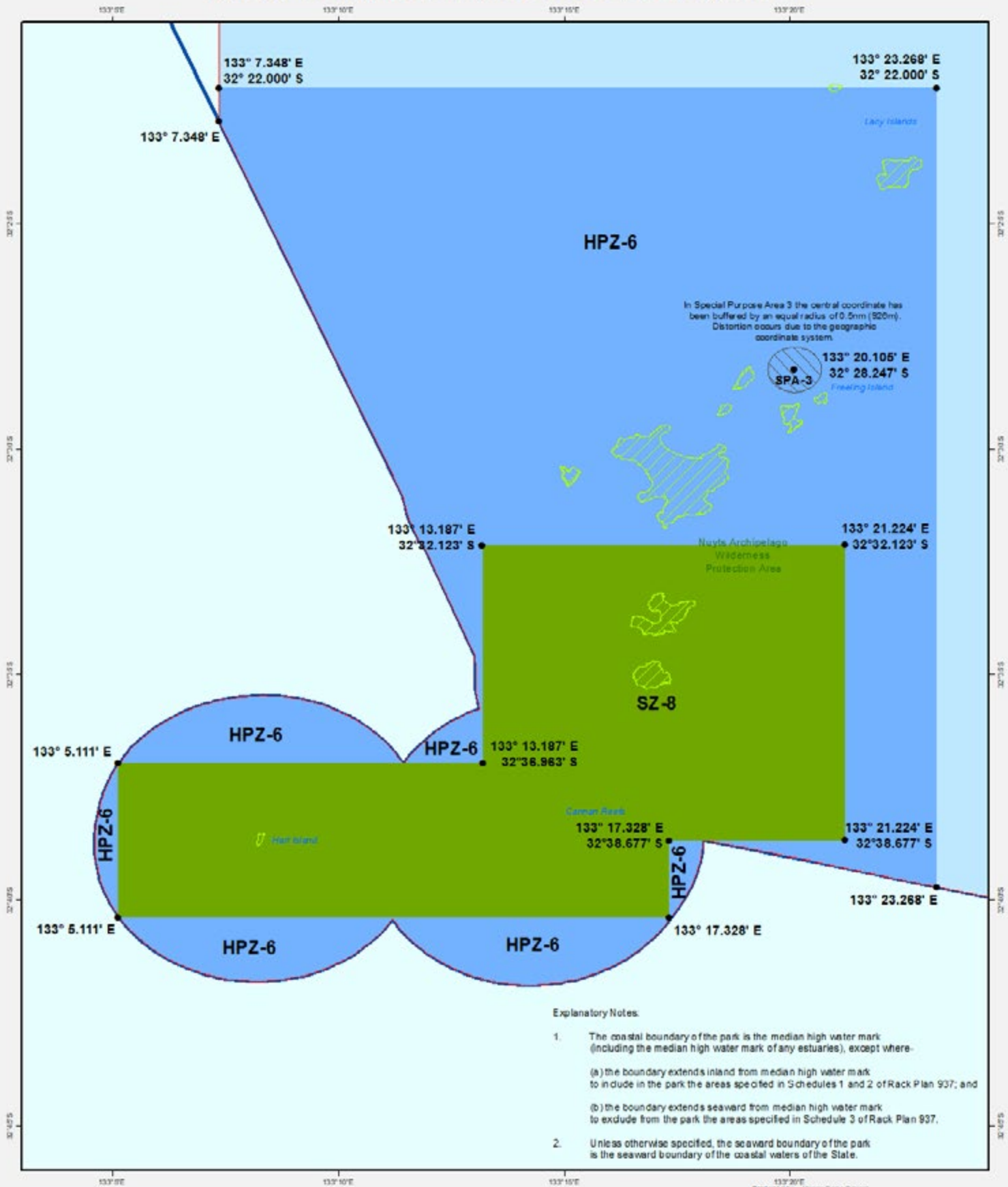

Map 05(A) - Sanctuary Zone 8, Habitat Protection Zone 6, Special Purpose Area 3

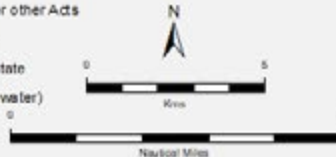
